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Summary

Ruptash ., Radzyniak . Communicative Rationality of Transdisciplinary Research.

The authors of the article analyzed the differences between disciplinary and postdisciplinary science, identified the main features of transdisciplinary research in terms of changes in methodology. The role of communicative rationality, as a basis for communication and interaction of scientists, and interested members from the non-scientific environment in transdisciplinary research are outlined. It is concluded that disciplinary science is an essential stage in the constitution of science as a way of cognition, formalizing of the results and establishing a social institution. The current stage of science development is called postdisciplinary, emphasizing on the prefix post- which means not so much a denial of the previous stage, as a dialectical synthesis of discipline and various forms of its transformation (inter-, cross-, trans-, etc.). It was found that post-disciplinary science, respectively, is characterized by new methodological tools, and more broadly – a methodology that goes not only beyond individual scientific fields, disciplines, but also beyond science in general. The universal background of such a methodology is the communicative practice of research participants, and the philosophical and theoretical justification is the appeal to communicative rationality. The authors initiated a discussion of the methodological potential of J. Habermas' theory to normalize research practice involving both scientists and external players (stakeholders), taking into account the differences between the concepts of communicative rationality of J.Habermas and K.-O. Apel and the specifics of transdisciplinary research.
